In Year 1 the children will be asked to complete homework each week. Please support your child by helping them to complete this. In Reception the children have phonics tins. Please take time to help them learn the letters and to sound out and blend the words.

"Show and Tell" is every Friday and we ask that toys are kept at home all other days.

### Literacy

The children will continue their Phonics work this half term which will include listening games, songs and activities. We will continue to provide opportunities for purposeful mark making within the areas. UFS children will be sounding out and writing short sentences and captions. Year 1 children will continue to develop their writing by writing short sentences independently, using their phonic knowledge to sound out words. We will also be using full stops, capital letters and finger spaces correctly.

Through our Literacy activities, all children will have daily opportunities for listening to stories, talking about characters, sequencing stories and making predictions about stories. This half term we will be reading a range of books from different cultures.

### Maths

In our maths lessons, children will learn to double and halve numbers. Year 1 will focus on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will be measuring capacity, length, height and weight.

### PE



Our weekly PE sessions will focus on throwing and catching and races. **Please remember to send in a named PE kit.** These can be kept at school for the half-term. Outside UFS will continue to learn a range of throwing and catching skills. Smaller motor activities will include a range of daily activities that will develop our fingers and get us ready for writing! Our climbing frame outside is also developing confidence, strength and balance on this equipment.

PE days are: Monday and Friday.

PSED In Personal, Social and Emotional Development sessions, we will focus on sharing, taking turns, playing well together and looking after ourselves. We will also be discussing the consequences of our actions.

We will be using maps and plans to find out about different places.

We will be finding out about the lifecycle of a butterfly

### ICT

UFS will have opportunities to use a variety of different programs to enhance their learning. Year 1 will be learning how to log on to the computers independently and will develop their typing skills.
