## Year 1

### Literacy

This half term, Year 1 children will have daily reading time, two daily phonics sessions and spelling/handwriting practice. They will complete comprehension tasks to support understanding of what they read, develop their knowledge of punctuation and grammar and share plenty of lovely stories as a class. In addition, we will be focusing on story writing and fairy tales!

### Science

The main focus for this half term will be humans and senses. The children will also be introduced to seasonal change, which they will continue to monitor over the forthcoming seasons.

### PSHE

Discussions and activities will focus on new beginnings and personal hygiene.

### Numeracy

In Numeracy, the children will learn about number and place value, including counting to and across one hundred, forwards and backwards from any given number. They will also recap the basic skills — addition and subtraction. Our topic work will focus on capacity, volume and 2D shapes.

### PE

Children will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities. They will also participate in a range of team games. We will encourage good teamwork at all times.

### Art and DT

The children will be exploring line and texture within Art and Design, and healthy eating within Design & Technology.

### RE

In RE, we will study how and why Christians celebrate Harvest. Year 1 will also discover who they are and why they are special.

### ICT

The children will be learning to log on and off computers correctly. They will also develop a deeper understanding of how to be safe when using technology.
