This half term's topic is:
The World around us and beyond.

Literacy



This half term, the Year 2 children will continue to develop their basic Literacy skills. The children will also learn about basic grammar and a variety of spelling patterns. They will improve their use of basic punctuation and learn to use commas in lists and bullet points.

When writing the children will be learning about reports and recounts. They will also develop their comprehension skills linked to all subjects. The children will continue to join some letters.

Science



The children will learn about plants. Throughout this unit the children will learn about what plants need to survive. They will

investigate how plants can change with temperature and other conditions.

We will also observe and record results during tests. They will learn how to sort plants using different methods and give reasons for their answers.

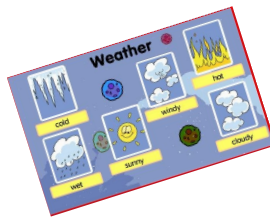
Numeracy



In Numeracy, the children will continue to reinforce their basic skills. They will practice written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will also reinforce skills in mental maths to help the children solve problems accurately using a range of strategies. In topic maths we will look at measuring time and mass, and will continue to learn about money.

Topic



In geography lessons the children will learn about the weather around us. They will learn about how the weather changes the landscape and habitats.

They will also identify the natural and man-made features and research how soil and rocks are moved.

Computing

In Computing the children will continue to develop their knowledge of how to stay safe when using multi media technology. They will also continue to develop their typing skills using the keyboard. The children will learn about coding involving programmable devices.



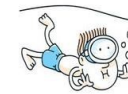
PSHE
