Year 4/5 Topic Letter



Art/ICT



In art, the children will be learning about textiles. They will create a joint textile banner about the Romans in Britain. They will design and make a Roman Shield mosaic. They will also create artistic posters about themselves. We hope to design and make a Roman shield.

In ICT, the children will sort and search different data bases and will then create their own database on Roman emperors. They will also learn about the Internet: its origins and what it is. They will then search the Internet safely to learn about their work in science.



Science

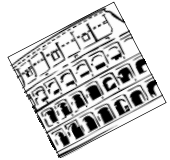


In science, the children will learn about animals, including humans. They will find out about food groups and about healthy balanced diets. They will study the human digestive system and learn about how food is transported around the body. They will compare diets of herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. The children will also investigate teeth and find out what causes decay. Finally, they will look closely at food chains and food webs.

Literacy



This half term, the Year 4/5 children will learn about poems and narrative writing. They will learn the features of each type of genre. The children will learn to write a variety of poems and will be able to write their own story. In addition, Year 4/5 will do work on myths and the history of the Ancient Romans. They will read and listen to information about Ancient Rome (both fiction and non-fiction) and will then be able to speak, listen and respond to the subject in a variety of ways.

They will also continue to do weekly spelling, punctuation, grammar and handwriting work, as well as a range of reading comprehension tasks.

PSHE

In PSHE this half term, Year 4/5 will learn about getting on and falling out. They will develop their knowledge and understanding of social and emotional aspects of learning which are: empathy, managing feelings (particularly anger) and improving social skills.



R.E.

Year 4/5 will learn about the religion of Hinduism. They will look at the origins of Hinduism; how they worship and what their beliefs are. They will also learn about their most important religious festival, the festival of Divali. They will read about the story of Rama and Sita.



Numeracy

In numeracy, the children will complete number work involving the four operations. They will also cover work across a range of maths topics: place value, shapes, problem solving and learning about the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes. The children will also continue weekly skills work, mental maths work, times tables work and numeracy games to help improve their mental strategies.

P.E.

This half term, Year 4 children will learn the skills necessary for competitive small sided games, (particularly bench ball and netball). They will understand the importance of rules and will make up their own games, including appropriate rules.



Topic

The children will learn about Ancient Rome and in particular about: where Ancient Rome is on a history timeline; the founding of Rome and the myth of Romulus and Remus; the Roman ruling system; Roman conquests; the Roman invasion of Britain and about the Roman General, Gaius Marius and his importance in the reorganisation of the Roman Army. Finally, they will learn about Queen Boudicca and her relationship with the Romans.
