- Regular swimming lessons – at Guisborough Baths throughout the year
- Educational Visits – Entrance fees; coaches for termly visits; subsidising residential visit for Y6; whole school pantomime trip; travel to sports festivals and competitions
- Specialist music tuition
- Enhanced curriculum provision – Durham University “Brilliant Club”; Children Challenging Industry; Termly Author/ Actor visits & workshops, Specialist sports coaching.
